MEMBERSHIP RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Misrepresentation of legal residence, family information, or transfer of membership cards to unauthorized users will result in forfeiture of membership with no refund.
- 2. Lost membership cards will be replaced at the pool office, upon payment of a replacement fee.
- Pool Managers have the authority to suspend or revoke memberships of swimmers who fail to comply with stated pool rules and instruction of pool staff.
 This is a family facility, public displays of affection, foul language and acts of aggression will not be tolerated. Pool Managers may deny entrance or remove individuals who display flagrant conduct to staff or guests.
- With the exception of authorized service animals, pets and animals are not allowed within the pool facility.
- The entire swimming pool complex is designated as a nonsmoking facility.

FACILITY RULES AND REGULATIONS

*****Please respect our pool and members. Kindly review additional rules posted at facility *****

- 1. Proper bathing attire is mandatory. Swimming in street clothes, gym clothing, and shorts is NOT permitted.
- 2. Swimmy Diapers & Plastic Pants Per Pennsylvania State & Montgomery County Health Code, all children in diapers must wear swimmy diapers with snug fitting plastic pants on top. Children should be encouraged to use the restroom before entry into the pools, and periodically throughout their stay at the facility.
- Swimmers with any illness or symptoms of COVID should avoid using the facility. Fecal incidents will require the immediate closure of the pool facility.
 COVID issues may result in pool closures or limited access to the facility.
- Glass containers of all kinds are strictly prohibited. This includes infant bottles and food jars. Broken glass is a significant safety hazard and may cause prolonged closure of the pool.
- 5. Outside food and beverages are limited. No outside food deliveries are permitted. Small coolers with snacks and drinks are allowed in grass areas only. Our concession stand offers a variety of food and beverage items. Guests reserving the party room may bring outside food and beverage for the party room NO ALCOHOL IS PERMITTED ON OR AROUND THE SOUDERTON COMMUNITY POOL FACILITY.
- 6. Children 12 years of age or younger must be accompanied by a parent or guardian 16 years of age or older.
- No tubes or floatation devices of any kind permitted in the pools.
- 8. Swimmers 12 years of age or younger must pass a deep-water test to swim in deep water over 3.5 feet. They must wear a designated wristband to swim in the deep water or use the lap pool.
- Half of the lower pool is reserved for adult and lap swimming.
- 10. Personal and swimming safety. No running, excessive horseplay, hanging on ropes/ lane lines, unauthorized use of diving blocks or dangerous use of diving board will be allowed.
- 11. There are certain risks associated with the use of a swimming pool and associated features within the facility. The Borough of Souderton and its officers, agents and employees cannot fully evaluate your or your dependent's physical abilities or limitations as they pertain to our use of this facility.

COVID POLICY STATEMENT

Memberships for the 2025 season are purchased with knowledge and understanding that there is an inherent risk of exposure to COVID19 in any public place where people congregate and as such members visiting the pool facility voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19. Face coverings are optional to the discretion of the patron. Anyone experiencing symptoms of COVID must refrain from using the facility. There may be times when capacity is reached and access to the facility will have to be restricted. Refunds will not be considered for COVID-related issues.

The pool will close early during inclement weather, unexpected emergencies or if less than 10 swimmers are using the facility. The pool will close early for scheduled swim meets and special events, dates will be posted at the office in advance. Daily entry cannot be guaranteed should the facility reach capacity.
